We are re instituting a long forgotten membership category - 6 month membership once used extensively by the football / cricketing fraternity.

We are pursuing Reciprocal Rights with Merimbula, Eden and Moree Golf Clubs. We will update as news comes in.

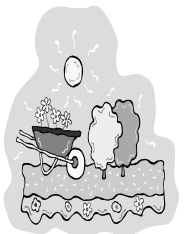
